Beaumont Youth Soccer Club Coach's Letter of Understanding

1. All coaches, assistants and trainers must register as a coach in Got Soccer. Background checks are required of all volunteers of BYSC. Registering and completing the profile in Got Soccer will allow the background check to be performed. Coaches, assistants and trainers are also required to complete the Safe Sport certification and the CDC Concussion Course. These courses can be found in your Got Soccer profile.
2. All players **MUST** wear shin guards at practice and during games. Shin guards should be completely covered by socks.
3. Children who are not registered players are not allowed to practice or play in games.
4. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of team parents at games.
5. Coaches are expected to conduct themselves appropriately during games and practices – set the example.
6. Harassment of referees or others will **NOT** be tolerated.
7. Referee calls are not grounds for protest.
8. Players are **NOT** allowed to play with a cast of any type. Players may **NOT** wear any kind of jewelry or hard barrettes or hair accessories during games. (Tape on earlobes covering earrings is **NOT** acceptable. They **MUST** be removed.)
9. Games will not be canceled or rescheduled without prior approval by the Spindletop Scheduler.
10. If a coach is asked to leave the field during a game he/she may be subject to a BYSC D & P (Discipline & Protest) hearing.
11. Only the coach will address the referee during the game.
12. Standings will not be kept for U8 and below.
13. U4, U5, and U6 will practice no more than 1 hour per week on game weeks or 2 hours per week before the season starts.
14. All coaches will participate in an age appropriate Grassroots Coaching course within their first year of coaching.
15. Coaches will provide BYSC with a **correct** e-mail address through their registration in Got Soccer. (This is very important as this is the only way we have to contact you with information you'll need regarding schedules, rain-outs, etc.)
